



### Our Capital Stack Toolbox


JCDA leverages a diverse mix of capital sources:

- Federal/State grants (USDA, EDA, WV Commerce)
- Congressionally Directed Spending (Earmarks)
- Opportunity Zones (Permanently extended via OBBBA, July 2025)
- Historic & New Markets Tax Credits
- PILOT Agreements & TIF/STIF tools
- Philanthropic, mission-aligned investment
- Private sector debt/equity



## Project: Burr Business/Industr ial Park

- ~315 acres across 3 phases (Bardane, Burr Industrial, & Burr Business)
- All lots under contract as of 2025
- Benefits: Fully utilized zoning and infrastructure investment



## Project: New Business Park + Flex Space

- Site search underway with RK&K
- ARPA funds supporting planning
- Feasibility study for on-site flex space facility
- Goal: Flexible leasing options and diversified revenue





Project: Sports
Complex /
Convention Center

- Feasibility study underway
- Inspired by The Bridge and similar complexes (Bridgeport, WV  $\rightarrow$  \$18M/yr impact)
- Potential for youth sports tourism, events, and venue-based revenue

#### Appalachian Pour Trail & Craft Beverage Sector

- Regional branding, tourism, and small producer support
- Multiple tracks: marketing, business incubation, policy development, land access, transit, workforce, ag science
- Opportunity to elevate
   Jefferson County as a craft beverage destination

# How Meetings Are Conducted

- Board of Directors Meetings are every 3rd Tuesday monthly
- They can be attended in person or online (with camera on)
- · They are public and recorded
- Executive Session is private and confidential only property and personnel topics can be discussed
- Agenda topics must be placed on the public agenda with specificity and an indication of whether action will possibly be taken
- No topics can be deliberated that aren't on the public agenda
- Any meeting of a quorum of Board members, in person, by phone, or electronically, where deliberation takes place (even if no decisions are acted on), must be noticed as a public meeting
